

Reserve Online!

You can reserve a museum pass up to two months in advance online from the Marlborough Public Library website.

What you need:

Your Library card number and PIN

To begin:

Visit www.marlbroughpubliclibrary.org

Under the **Services** tab, select **Museum Passes**. (please note, you will also see the link under the **How Do I Find** selection on the Library homepage)

Once you are on the **Museum Passes** page, you can click on museum names to learn more about our passes as well as request passes.

Reserve your pass:

Museums are listed in alphabetical order by date. You can browse by date, or search the site using the drop down menus at the top of the list. Click the "Request Pass" button to the left of the museum you wish to visit. You will then be prompted to enter your Library card number and PIN to complete the reservation.

Don't know your PIN?

Your PIN defaults to the last four digits of the phone number you gave during your Library card registration. If you are unsure, please call the Library and we can help you reset that PIN.

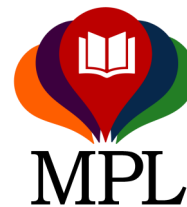

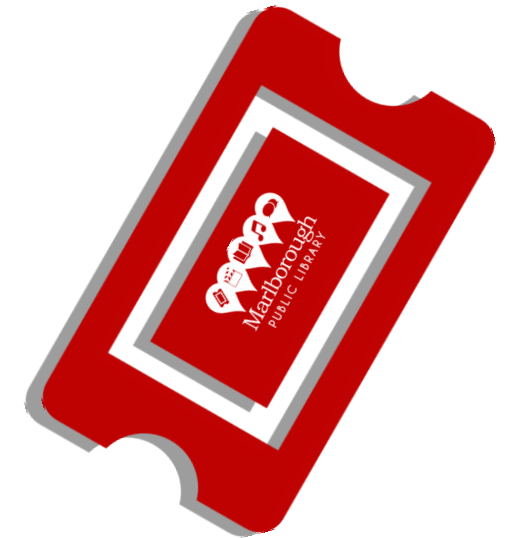

Museum Pass Policy

The Marlborough Public Library offers discount passes to area museums and other places of interest at no charge. The library's museum pass program follows the policies listed below.

- Only library patrons 18 years or older are able to reserve and check out museum passes.
- Patrons may only use one museum pass per day and book no more than four passes in a month.
- Passes may be picked-up the day before or the day of your reservation.
- To avoid fees, passes must be returned before the next day's opening hour. Passes can be placed in the outdoor book drop.
- A \$5 per day fee is assessed for all passes returned late.
- A fee of \$5 is assessed to patrons who reserve a pass and fail to pick it up.
- A \$10 charge will be assessed to patrons for all returnable museum passes lost.
