

## Museum Pass Policy

The library offers discount passes to area museums and other places of interest at no charge. The library's museum pass program follows the policies listed below.

- Only library patrons 18 years or older are able to reserve and check out museum passes.
- Patrons may only use one museum pass per day and book no more than four passes in a 30-day period.
- Passes may be picked up the day before or the day of your reservation. **Passes not picked up by noon on the reservation date will be released to other patrons.**
- To avoid fees, passes must be returned before the next day's opening hour. Passes can be placed in the outdoor book drop.
- A \$5 per day fee is assessed for all passes returned late. A \$10 charge will be assessed to patrons for all returnable museum passes lost.
- To cancel your reservation, please call the library at 508-624-6900.

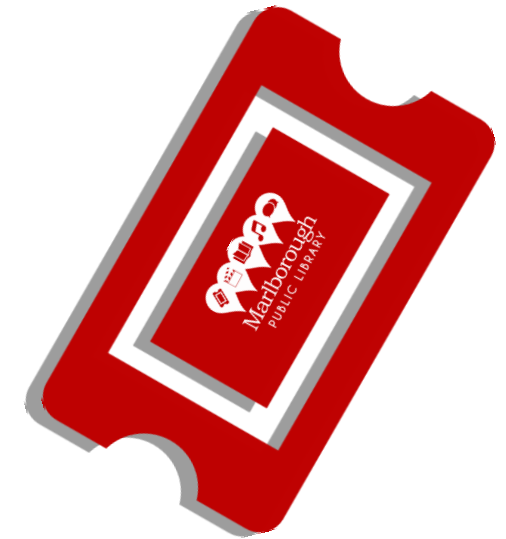
